

How do I register for NYLT?

Any scout that wants to participate in the NYLT 2012 course and meets the eligibility requirements should complete this registration and submit a deposit of \$50 of the \$150 course fee to the Coastal Carolina Service Center before February 1, 2012. Applications will be reviewed and a complete information package will be sent if you are selected to attend.

Age and Rank Requirements

The following are the minimum requirements to attend NYLT:

- ⇒ 13 or Older
- ⇒ First Class/Venturer or Higher
- ⇒ Presently are or going to be leader in your troop
- ⇒ Recommendation by Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor

Full Course Selection Criteria

All scouts that meet age and rank requirements can register for this course. If the course reaches the maximum number for scouts on Feb 1st, the selection criteria will be as follows: Our objective at NYLT is to have a trained scout in every troop. Because there are 100+ troops/crews and only 48 slots, space is extremely limited. There will be three types of enrollment for NYLT – 2012; primary, alternate, and open troop representatives. Each troop can only select one primary and one alternate all other scouts from that troop are open selections. Once all primary representatives have been given slots (in order of registration), the alternates will be given slots by a random drawing if available. Once we have all primary and alternates assigned, all open registrations will be selected by drawing until all spaces are filled. After Feb 1st, the order is as received.

What is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is a two weekend six day experience conducted by the Coastal Carolina Council designed to provide each Scout with a meaningful experience in Leadership. This experience will enhance his knowledge and create deeper understanding of his roles and responsibilities of being a leader.

The principles taught and used in this course will provide leadership potential in scouting, school, and life.

What to expect?

The course is designed to provide activities and skills that you will need to be an effective leader in your troop. You will meet other scouts in the council and share ideas and knowledge.

You will be assigned to a team as part of a unit. You will camp with your team and participate in activities with your team. You will learn effective teaching, communications, and leadership.

\$ 50 – Deposit Due with Registration

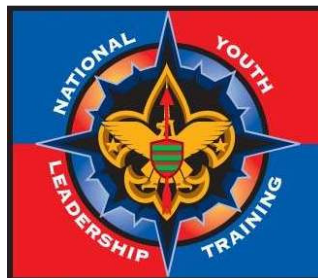
\$150 – Total Cost per Scout
