

How do I register for Staff NYLT?

Any scout that wants to be on Staff for NYLT 2012 course and meets the eligibility requirements should complete this registration before November 15, 2011. Applications will be reviewed and a complete information package will be called if you are selected for staff. Please make sure the e-mail and phone number provided are working and checked.

Age and Rank Requirements

The following are the minimum requirements to attend NYLT:

- ⇒ 14 or Older
- ⇒ First Class or Higher
- ⇒ Previously Attended NYLT
- ⇒ Recommendation by Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor

Selection Criteria

Staff will be selected based on their experience and the recommendation of their unit leaders. Each person requesting to join staff will be given an interview to determine the best position for that scout. We need both male and female staff members. The senior positions on staff will be appointed by the Course Director based on your participation and experience. There are mandatory meetings for staff training. One meeting will be an all day meeting on Saturday January 7, 2012. Other staff training will be held to provide additional training as conveniently as possible. Senior staff will be required to attend a walk-thru at the camp the weekend prior to the event. Staff is expected to live by the scout oath and law at all times.

What is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is a two weekend six day experience conducted by the Coastal Carolina Council designed to provide each Scout with a meaningful experience in Leadership. This experience will enhance his knowledge and create deeper understanding of his roles and responsibilities of being a leader.

The principles taught and used in this course will provide leadership potential in scouting, school, and life.

What to expect?

The course is designed to provide activities and skills that you will need to be an effective leader in your troop. You will meet other scouts in the council and share ideas and knowledge.

You will be assigned to a patrol as part of a troop. You will camp with your patrol and participate in activities with your patrol. You will learn effective teaching, communications, and leadership.

Course Payment Policy

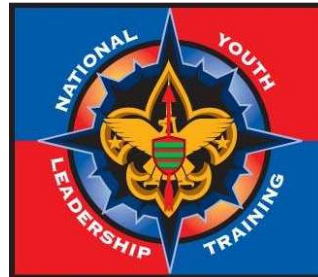
Staff may be required to pay for food, the amount will be determined at staff training meetings.

- Fees must be Paid in Full before course
- Scout may lose participation in course if fees **not paid by due date**. (Alternate scouts may be given your slot)
- Registration **does not** mean Acceptance as a Staff Member
- Refunds will only be given prior to start of course as specified in Refund Policy
- Scouts requiring assistance in paying fees contact the Council Representative or Course Director

NYLT Course Objectives

- Develop skills and confidence to be a leader in your Troop
- Provide a clear understanding of team building and personal development
- Understand and apply skills in Ethical Decision, Conflict Resolution and Effective Leadership

Participants that successfully complete NYLT are eligible to attend National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience (NAYLE) (At Philmont)



Training will begin at 5:00PM on Friday and conclude at 4:00PM Sunday at each session for staff. Staff members are expected to remain until these times even if their ride arrives early. Staff members are expected to wear complete Official Scout Uniform as specified in the material that will be provided to each staff member.
